##### **IMPORTANT POST-SECONDARY INFORMATION FOR CURRENT GRADE 11 STUDENTS**

Students who wish to apply for admission to post-secondary institutions must obtain an "official transcript" directly from the Ministry of Education. In order to ensure students have access to request an "official transcript", students need to follow the steps outlined in the link below, starting with completing the *MyCreds Student Email Submission Form*. Some institutions accept early admission applications as early as October, so you will want to ensure that your child's *MyCreds Student Email Submission Form* is submitted before the end of this school year.
