PARENT PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM
<p>The Parent Partnership program is vital to building up our school community. By contributing 8 hours of service each year, parents help keep our costs and tuition reasonable and, even more importantly, develop friendships with other parents and foster a sense of ownership so critical to the health of our community.</p> <p>In the interest of fairness and easy management, we require all parents who will be volunteering to provide a \$400 post-dated cheque, which will be deposited only if their service commitment is not satisfied.</p> <p>NOTE: Although we would much prefer your time than your money, we understand there may be circumstances that make it difficult to volunteer so we do offer an option to “buy-out” for \$400/parent.</p>

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • SCS is pleased to offer financial assistance to qualifying families who would otherwise be unable to attend because of financial hardship. Awards of financial assistance are based on an analysis conducted by Apple Financial Services (www.applefinancialservices.ca) of a family’s ability to contribute towards educational expenses. • Apple Financial Services charges a \$100 fee per family to perform an analysis. SCS will provide a \$50 reimbursement to those families who choose to enroll their child(ren), regardless of the outcome of the financial assistance application process. • Funding is limited so it is important to apply early. • In order to help us determine the amount of funds we will have available to assist new families for an upcoming school year, returning families must submit their applications for financial assistance by April 30, 2019. • Contact the Business Office at 306-343-1494, ext. 285, for further information.
