ON STAGE

Location: Multipurpose Room. Performances: maximum 6 minutes

Performances must be previewed and approved by parents. Final approval will be given by a staff member. Students are welcome to perform in the *Commons* as well.

All students performing in the Multipurpose Room must have their music and costumes at school to participate in the technical rehearsal.

- Videos must be given to Mrs. Funk by May 1.
- Music needs to be performed for Mrs. Nickel Lemke and any accompaniment given to her on a memory stick or by email to <u>nickellemkel@saskatoonchristianschool.ca</u> by **May 1**.
- Auditions will be held on May 1, 2, & 5.

Location: Commons Area

Chairs will be set up for those wishing to stop awhile and enjoy the street performers. You are welcome to perform at *On Stage* as well.
