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## SCHOOL START-UP INFORMATION 2025-2026

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### FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL: TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 2

The anticipated schedule for our first morning is:

8:45 am - 10:30 am	<b>Class Time (Homerooms) &amp; Coffee Time (Commons)</b> K-12 students will proceed to their homerooms and begin classes. Class lists will be posted. Refreshments and seating will be available for parents who wish to stay and visit one another in the Commons until chapel begins.
10:30 am - 11:30 am	<b>“Welcome Back” Chapel (Gym)</b> Chapel will be held in the gym and will include a welcome time, staff introductions, the theme verse for 2025-2026 and a brief devotional. Parents are invited to attend.
<b>IMPORTANT TO NOTE:</b>	<b>Students from K-12 are dismissed, but welcome to participate in our afternoon events. <u>Students in grades K-6 must be picked up by parents from their classrooms after chapel and must be supervised by their parents.</u> Teacher supervision will not be available after chapel.</b>
12:00 pm - 1:00 pm	<b>Family BBQ (Gym/School Grounds)</b> Gluten-free and dairy-free options will be provided. All parents and students are invited to attend.
1:00 pm - 2:15 pm	<b>Meet the Teacher Event (Grade K-8 in Classrooms. Grade 9-12 in Multipurpose Room)</b> Teachers will be available meet parents and provide information about the year ahead. This is a “come and go” event with no formal agenda.
2:15 pm - 3:00 pm	<b>Fun &amp; Games (School Grounds)</b> Everyone is welcome to join us outside for games. Students in grades K-6 must be supervised by a parent.
2:15 pm - 3:00 pm	<b>New Parent Orientation Event (Multipurpose Room)</b> All parents who are new to SCS this year should plan to attend. Bring your questions!

All students should bring school supplies on the first day. Teachers will be ready to assign spaces, desks, and/or lockers.

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## GRADES K-12: MEDICATION AT SCHOOL & HEALTH INFORMATION REPORTING

Students in grades K-12 who require medication while at school need to have a completed *Medication Dispense Form* on file at the School Office. A new form is required at the start of each school year. **All medication for all students**, from Tylenol, Advil, and Reactine to EpiPens and Asthma puffers, etc. must be stored at the **School Office** (not in a student locker, in a desk or on their person). This ensures that medication is stored safely and in a specific location accessible to all adults assisting students with medical situations.

Students who do not require medication but do have medical or health conditions that staff should be aware of are asked to complete a *Health Information Form*. This would include but not be limited to conditions that would cause fainting, seizures, severe anxiety, behavioural concerns or a diagnosis such as ADHD or Autism. This information assists staff in understanding your child and providing the best possible care when a concern arises.
