A dress rehearsal will take place on Wednesday, May 1, at 1 pm. All students performing in the multipurpose room must have their music and costumes at school to participate in the dress rehearsal. Videos must be given to Mr. Baetz by April 18. Music needs to be given on a USB or by email to Mrs. Hind by April 18.

Location: Commons Area

Location: Times Square (main doors of the Commons Area)
