



**TOBOGGANS AT SCHOOL**

With the arrival of the snow, students are eager to get on the hill for sledding. Students are allowed on the hill on any day but must follow the guidelines set out by the supervisor. Older students are separated from the younger students for safety reasons. Please follow the guidelines below:

1. Please remember that only soft sleds are to be used at school (no GTs, wooden toboggans, or standing sleds are allowed). Make sure sleds are labeled with your child’s name to ensure they get it back at the end of the season. Students bring sleds at their own risk.
2. Supervisors will remind students to look before they go down the hill so they don’t crash into other students.
3. No pushing or roughhousing is permitted.

**ICE RINK SAFETY**

Once the ice rink is operational, students will need to follow these guidelines:

1. The rink can only be used during the lunch recess.
2. One half of the rink is available for hockey and one half of the rink is available for skating. Each side should respect the other's space.
3. Students can bring their skates, helmets, hockey sticks, and pucks from home and are responsible for their storage.
4. Anyone using the rink is required to use a properly fitted CSA approved hockey helmet for their safety. Snowboard or bike helmets cannot be used. If the student is playing hockey on the ice, they will be required to have a face cage. If the student is skating only, they do not need a face cage.
5. Students must be able to get their own skates on and off as we do not always have enough supervision to accommodate this extra help at the rink.
6. Supervisors will be asked make sure students are off the ice at least five minutes before the bell in order to get skates off and get to class on time.
