### **Value**

The Saskatchewan Chapter of the Association of Certified Fraud Examiners will award scholarships valued at \$500.00 for up to two Saskatchewan High School students.

### **Eligibility**

All students in grades 9 to 12 attending a Saskatchewan High School, except for previous winners of this award, are eligible upon submission of an essay. All essays\* must be type-processed in English and limited to no more than four pages (type-processed, double-spaced). Considerable emphasis will be placed by the judges on the content including research on the topic, references, grammar and the syntax. Please include your name, your grade, and the name of your school.

### **Topic**

Submit an essay in your own words explaining how you would protect your grandparents from scams and fraud that originates through the internet, email, etc. We are looking for you to identify potential scams/frauds, how you can protect them and information gained through research in your neighborhood, personal knowledge or experiences. The essay topic is:

Your Grandparents – How would you protect them from internet, email, social media scams and frauds?
